 Normalize LGBT themes in movies, sports, art, and film. Create gender non-specific events and spaces. Ex. all families day in addition to Mother's Day Woodworking Studio rather than "men's tool shop." Invitation to parties: "Come dance with your friend, spouse, or just by yourself."
